Purpose

The FGMB Church Internship Program provides opportunities for an intern to receive personal and spiritual mentoring as well as leadership development, ministry experience and a glimpse into the life of a person in ministry through participation and leadership in summer ministries of the congregation.

Duties and Responsibilities

Primary Responsibilities:

Canoe Trip Leader/Coordination

- Planning and preparation for Jr. High, Sr. High, and C&C Canoe Trips
- Leadership of canoe trip activities
- Take a ministry leadership role on each of the canoe trips

Secondary Responsibilities:

Youth Ministry Support

- Assist the Youth Pastor as directed in office/seasonal tasks

Qualifications

Qualifications and Requirements include:

- A follower of Jesus Christ, able to affirm the MB Confession of Faith
- Preference given to active members of a Mennonite Brethren congregation
- Must be a post-secondary student planning to return to studies in the fall or currently completing their final year of studies
- Preference given to those enrolled in ministry-related studies
- Teachable spirit and demonstrated desire to learn
- Able to work independently and take initiative
- Strong interpersonal communication skills – written and verbal
- Strong organizational skills and ability to lead a team of volunteers
- Relevant experience with canoe tripping/outdoor education
- The successful applicant must be willing to undergo abuse registry and police background checks
